## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will create a 402-acre fuel break in a semi-circular area of forest and chaparral shrub fields located north and west of the community of Mokelumne Hill in Calaveras County. This fuel break will reduce fuel loads and the risk of catastrophic fire in an area that has a history of destructive wildfires. Treatments along roads will enhance ingress and egress by emergency vehicles and the traveling public during emergencies. The fuel break will provide a staging area for fire suppression forces to effectively fight a wildfire.

The project will utilize a combination of mechanical mastication and hand treatments. In either case, the treatment objectives are the same. Mastication involves the shredding of material in place. Material produced by hand cutting with chainsaws will either be lopped and scattered to a depth not to exceed 12 inches or chipped and spread. In areas dominated by chaparral brush will be reduced to five percent or less ground cover while retaining some patches of older manzanita or other shrubs for visual diversity and as wildlife habitat. Vigorous conifers and some hardwood trees occurring within brush will be targeted for retention and if in dense stands, will be thinned to a spacing of 30 feet between boles. Suppressed and low vigor trees under 12 inches diameter will be targeted for removal.

The project may utilize a combination of other treatments to reduce or remove incompatible vegetation within the fuel break. These treatments may include hand thinning and chipping, piling and burning, pruning, the application of herbicides and/or other treatment methods.

The intent is for this Notice of Exemption to cover ongoing maintenance of the project in perpetuity.
